


RIGGING HAND PLACEMENT





SYNTHETIC RIGGING

Is the signal man really looking out for me?


Signal and rig at same time?






RIGGING PANELS

PINCH / CRUSH POINT



Keep hands and fingers away from the connectors when using rigging.


RIGGING KEEP YOUR HANDS IN THE RIGHT PLACE




RIGGING CRUSH POINT

Hold the wire rope high enough to eliminate the hazard.

RIGGING KEEP YOUR HANDS IN THE RIGHT PLACE





TAGLINES / ROPE

PINCH POINT

NEVER wrap a rope or and tag line around your hand or body.

If using a tag line, make sure your eyes stay on it until it is above your chest to avoid snags or it catching on something.
